

Child Protection Specialist

Responsibilities:

The Child Protection Specialist serves as Country office expert in child protection. Gives guidance and supports Church Partners in any related concerns in physical and psycho-social well-being of registered children.

- Acts as an advocate for children by raising awareness on child abuse and the needs and potentials of child abuse survivors in poverty
- Assists local Church Partners through the Partnership Facilitators in formulating their local Child Protection Policies and Procedures in child case management.
- Gives guidance and support to Compassion projects in cases of child abuse in all the core programs

- Consolidates reported cases at the country level and provides timely reports to the CMT.
- Serves as Subject Matter Expert in Child Protection.
- Networks and builds alliances with other government and non-government agencies.
- Develops necessary protocols and inter-agency referral guidelines that will assist in the actual implementation of child protection system.

Requirements:

- Christian maturity characterized by a strong Christian testimony, a heart for ministry, and knowledge of the Scriptures.
- Bachelor's degree is required, with a preference towards field-related Social Sciences such as Social Work, Psychology, Family Life and Child Development, or Christian Ministry.
- A minimum of three years professional or intensive volunteer experience relevant to working with abused children, communities and ministries, and child protection service agencies.
- Strong interpersonal relationship skills. conducive to establishing trusting relationships with a wide variety of people, including children.
- Ability to work with only occasional supervision.
- Good leadership, case management, and problem-solving skills. Ability to reflect Compassion's Leadership Principles.
- Partner service orientation.
- Good written communication skills and strong verbal communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work with the broad spectrum of Evangelical denominations and churches.
